ANNUAL REPORT 2018-19

Dear Patrons.

Let me present you with our activities for the year 2018-2019.

Student population served is 5,753 (up from 5,189) students. In the past year we have opened new book bank, science lab, computer and vocational centers. Here's the breakdown of our educational projects.

- 3 AALO Study Homes serving 65 pre-elementary school students (no change from last year)
- 19 AALO Coaching Homes (up from 18) serving 395 students (up from 365):12 High School Coaching Centers, 7
 Primary Coaching Centers.
- 400 (up from 350) SMILE scholarships for high school and college students.
- 18 Computer Centers (up from 15), now serving around 4,209 students (up from 3,288).
- 3 (up from 1) Vocational Training Center serving 52 (up from 10) students
- 8 (up from 6) Book Banks serving over 1502 students (up from 975)
- 1 new science lab serving 142 students

AALO Centers

<u>Pre-Primary Study and Primary Coaching home</u>: We have three centers serving students from pre-primary grades and five centers serving grades III-IV grades, at Behala, Boral, Narendrapur, Dhulai, Hijaldiha, Suklai and Narrah serving 115 students. We have two centers, at Narrah and at Dhulai (TORCHS) where our past alumni volunteers to give as teachers.

<u>High School Coaching Center</u>: We have 12 centers serving 281 students in Math and English at Bandel, Dhulai, Narrah, Hijaldiha, Ghatsila, Asanbani, Magura, and Ganjam. 100% of the students at Ghatsila, passed the state board exam in the 1st division, an incredible result given the very challenging background of these students.

Computer & Vocational Training Centers

We are serving 4209 students at 18 computer centers at Ghatsila, Hotar, Dhulai, Kulbani, Hijaldiha, Amdanga, Bandel, Radhamohanpur, Kolkata, Jaunpur, Narrah, Hubballi, Dharwad & Baharagora. The BDSL Mahila College, Ghatsila, Jharkhand center was opened on Jan 12. This is girls' residential college for backward classes and this Center can help train 150 students annually.

We upgraded the existing facilities for computer learning at Adarsh High School at Dharwad, Karnataka and Ramakrishna Vivekananda International School at Baharagora, Jharkhand.

We are expanding vocational centers for AC, refrigeration, and mobile phone repair, and tailoring. The Bandel AC/refrigeration center with 26 students was opened. We also opened the Narrah and Dhulai centers. We are now planning to open the next center at for house-wiring and electrical appliance repair at Ghatsila.

Three sewing machines were added at Narrah. Ms Soma Sen, a past graduate has started a home -based business.

SMILE Scholarship

We now have over 400 scholars across the states of W. Bengal, Jharkhand, U.P, Odisha, and Karnataka. Our SMILE scholars continue to blaze the trail every year. Sayantan Basak from Gangarampur High School ranked 8th in the state Class X Board Exam scoring 97.5%. His father runs a small shop. Sayantan aspires to be a doctor.

Other India initiatives

The Heeramoti Reading Hall, Dhulai, was inaugurated on 24 February. This air-conditioned hall allows free access to reference books, CDs, seminars and a capacity to accommodate 30 students.

We inaugurated a Science Lab and Book-Bank on Jan 28 at Jhanjhia High School, Balichak, Purba Midnapore. This is an economically depressed area. The school previously lacked both- books and a science lab. We plan to open three new labs at Yashoda Women's College, Ganjam, BDSL Inter College, Ghatsila and Saraswati Shishu Vidya mandir High School, Baharagora.

We opened a book bank at Kashida, Ghatsila. We plan to open two new bookbanks at Chakulia and Ganjam.

We donated for the flood affected victims in the eastern state of Orissa and the southern state of Kerala.

Healthcare activities

We have a number of programs to help with medical needs of the communities living around our existing centers. The Nivedita women's' center, at Narrah, holds regular clinics for women's' preventative care. We have added a mobile medical unit at this center.

Dhulai DMS center campus organized a blood donation and eye check-up camps. 132 People donated blood. 320 patients had their eyes checked, 100 eye glasses were distributed and some referred to for cataract surgery. Another medical camp was held at Berhampore (Orissa) with Rotary club, 157 patients attended the fair.

Events in USA

The Annual Spelling Bee fundraiser was held at the University of Texas at Dallas and was a grand success. We had a record 182 participants, divide into 5 categories from kindergarten to 8th grade. We thank our partners Indian Assoc. of North Texas (IANT), Indian Cultural Heritage Foundation, and Radio Caravan.

The Annual Lily Cricket Tournament fundraiser was a lively afternoon of games, food and entertainment. The Gully Boys upset defending champs Toyota Stunners in an exciting finals game. Twelve teams played and we were entertained by a superb dance program by Nritya Dance Academy. We thank our sponsors and partners- IANT and the indoor venue. Red Hot Chili Peppers restaurant, and FunAsia radio.

Our Bi- Annual Feed the Needy (FTN) Program is in its 26th year and continues to get strong support from the community. We feed more than 200 homeless people at Union Gospel Mission Church, Fort Worth, twice a year.

Lily and Toyota organized a well-attended fun-filled Diwali fundraiser last October at Toyota headquarters.

We welcome our new President Anirudha Maitra and Board Members.






