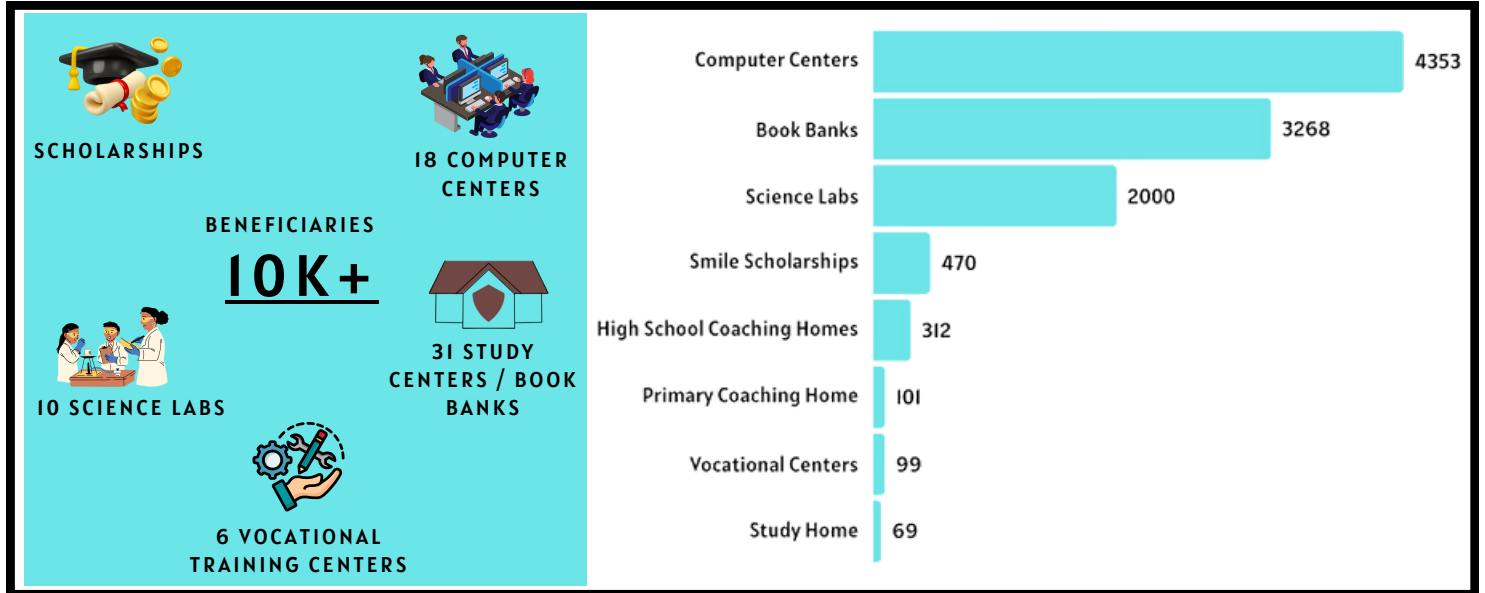
## Lily Youth Club

To support her dedication, the Lily Foundation has provided a one-time grant, ensuring she can continue her education without financial worries.

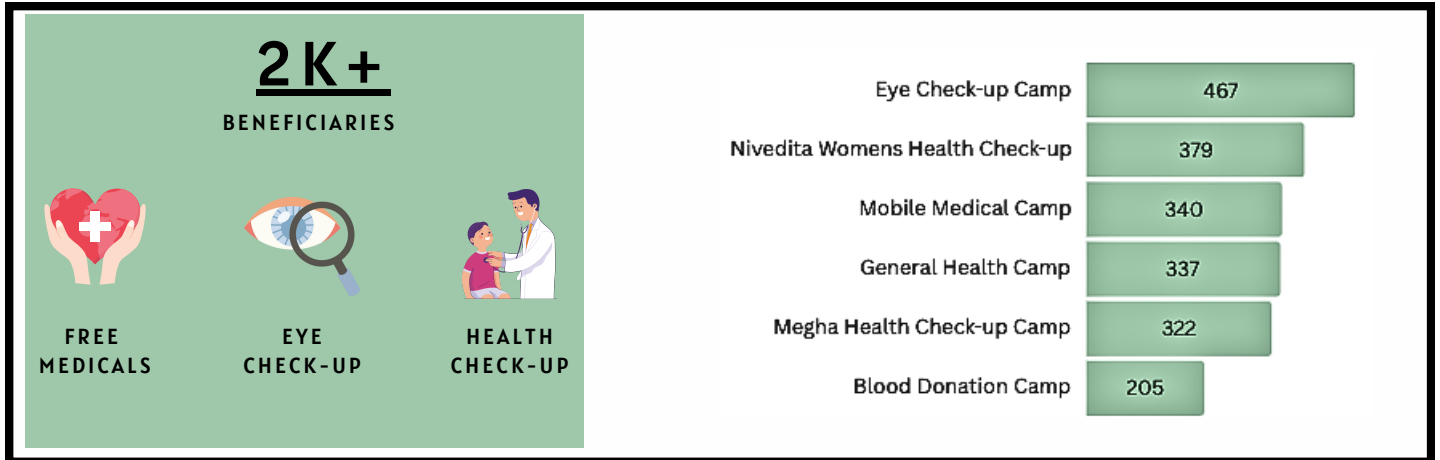
## Success Story
